विषय:- शासकीय चिकित्सालयों में निःशुल्क जांच सुविधा उपलब्ध कराने बाबत।

- संदर्भ:- 1. शासन का पत्र क्रमांक 125/2013/सत्रह/मेडि-2/भोपाल दिनांक 30.01.2013।
2. संचालक अस्प. प्रशा. का पत्र क्र./अ.प्रशा./सेल-3/2013/62 दि. 30.01.2013।

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1. वर्तमान में शासकीय चिकित्सालयों में विभिन्न स्तर की संस्थाओं में कई प्रकार की जांच सुविधाएं निःशुल्क उपलब्ध कराई जा रही है। पूर्व में जिला चिकित्सालयों में सभी रोगियों को 48 प्रकार की जांचें निःशुल्क उपलब्ध कराना सुनिश्चित किया गया था।

वर्तमान में आयुष्मान भारत योजना के अंतर्गत हितग्राहियों को निःशुल्क उपचार उपलब्ध कराया जाना है, एवं उपचार पैकेज के अंतर्गत की जाने वाली जांचों को भी निःशुल्क उपलब्ध कराया जाना है।

2. समस्त जिला चिकित्सालयों एवं 100 बिस्तरों से अधिक सिविल अस्पतालों में की जाने वाली पैथोलॉजी जांचों की सूची को पुनरीक्षित कर 50 प्रकार की जांचें सम्मिलित करने का निर्णय किया गया है (परिशिष्ट-‘अ’)।

इस पुनरीक्षित सूची में 50 प्रकार की जांचों में से 33 प्रकार की जांचों को संस्था में ही करना अनिवार्य होगा, ये जांचें आउटसोर्स नहीं की जावेगी। शेष 17 प्रकार की जांचें जिनके समक्ष स्टार मार्क अंकित है यदि किसी भी कारण से जिला चिकित्सालय/100 बिस्तर से अधिक सिविल अस्पतालों में नहीं की जा रही है, (जैसे- पैथालॉजिस्ट, उपकरण, रिएजेन्ट आदि की अनुपलब्धता) तो उन्हें डायग्नोसिस सर्विस की गाइडलाइन अनुसार आउटसोर्स कराया जा सकता है (परिशिष्ट-‘स’)।


3. परिशिष्ट-अ में वर्णित पुनरीक्षित 50 प्रकार की जांचें समस्त जिला चिकित्सालय/100 बिस्तर से अधिक सिविल अस्पतालों में आने वाले सभी रोगियों को निःशुल्क उपलब्ध किया जाना है।

4. इन 50 जांचों के अतिरिक्त 30 प्रकार की अन्य जांचें जो आयुष्मान भारत योजना के अंतर्गत पैकेज में सम्मिलित है, उन्हें केवल आयुष्मान भारत योजना के हितग्राहियों हेतु गाइडलाइन (परिशिष्ट-‘स’) अनुसार आउटसोर्स किया जा सकता है (परिशिष्ट-‘ब’)।

5. आयुष्मान भारत योजना के अंतर्गत जांचे एवं स्पेशलिस्ट चिकित्सकों को आउटसोर्स करने के लिए गठित कमेटी द्वारा दिशानिर्देश बनाए गए हैं। स्थानीय स्तर पर स्पेशलिस्ट चिकित्सकों को आउटसोर्स करने के लिए गाइडलाइन (परिशिष्ट -द) संलग्न है।

6. शेष चिकित्सालयों के लिए संदर्भित पत्र क्रमांक 2 अनुसार 100 बिस्तर से कम सिविल अस्पतालों में 32, सामुदायिक स्वास्थ्य केन्द्र में 28, प्राथमिक स्वास्थ्य केन्द्र में 16, उप स्वास्थ्य केन्द्र में 5 प्रकार की जांचे की व्यवस्था पूर्व की भांति यथावत रहेगी।



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**OUTSOURCING OF
DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES
GUIDELINES**

Guidelines for outsourcing of Diagnostic services at District Hospitals/100 bedded above Civil Hospitals of Madhya Pradesh

Diagnostics are an integral part of the health care system and provide information needed by service providers to make informed decisions about care provision related to prevention, screening, detection, treatment and management. In Madhya Pradesh under free Diagnostics service initiative diagnostic tests made available free to all patients coming to health facilities.

In District hospitals 48 Pathological tests were made essential to be performed at the facilities. But due to certain reasons it came into notice that few investigation could not be done at health facilities. For the effective implementation of Ayushman Bharat Scheme, & providing end to end free /cashless health care facilities to the beneficiaries it may be necessary to outsource certain diagnostic procedures for which the facility is not available at the District Hospital and 100 bedded above civil hospitals.

The list of the Pathological tests at District hospital and 100 bedded above civil hospitals has been revised and enumerated in sections. The revised list is having 50 tests out of which 33 tests has to be done in facilities only and they can not be outsourced. Reaming 17 tests (Asterisk Marked) can be outsourced according to provided guideline if these tests could not be done at facilities due to any reasons. (Unavailability of Pathologist, equipments, reagents and consumables)

General guidelines for selection of Laboratories and diagnostic services-:

- The selection of diagnostic services shall be based on an agreement between the Civil Surgeon cum office Superintendent of District Hospitals/100 bedded above Civil Hospitals and the Laboratory and diagnostic service center. The Civil surgeon may give advertisement and press release in local newspapers to invite interested diagnostic service centers. Since it is a tie-up so there shall be no requirement of publishing a tender.
- Tie up with multiple diagnostic service centers may be considered for outsourcing of the services.

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Criteria for Laboratories and diagnostic service selection:-

- The minimum annual turnover of the laboratory to be considered for selection shall be Ten (10) lakhs.
- The laboratory to be considered for tie up should have minimum One year of business operations.
- The laboratory should not be involved under criminal proceeding and not blacklisted (a self-declaration will be sufficient for same)
- Laboratories with whom the tie up is being considered should have Personnel with desired qualifications e.g. (Registered Radiologist, Pathologists, and Technicians.)
- Statutory guidelines with respect to the selection of diagnostic centers shall be followed while on boarding e.g. PCPNDT (Pre natal diagnostic testing) compliance, AERB (Atomic Energy Regulatory Board compliance), local body registrations, biomedical waste management requirement etc.

Operational Guidelines:-

- Patients who are beneficiaries of Ayushman Bharat Scheme will be referred to the diagnostic service centers with a referral note mentioning AB-NHPM ID and required investigations. This will be done only in case when the investigation is not available in the hospital.
- Laboratory shall send the personnel for collection of the samples. For diagnostic service other than laboratory center itself will make arrangement for patient transportation.
- All the operational cost which includes collection of sample, logistics and transportation in cold chain, testing, reporting of the result as per quality standards within the declared scope of work and also including the cost of deployment of the personnel will be borne by the service provider.
- For any doubtful observations/ wrong report the vendor has to retest the sample at his own cost of damage during transport, haemolysis and insufficient sample, the laboratory has to again take the sample and repeat the test.
- Under no circumstances the provider refuses services to the patients. Also no fees are collected from them.

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- The test will be performed and reports will be submitted within the agreed timelines (TAT) as annexed (Annexure-II). The hard copy report will be submitted or handed over to patient in health institution. The AB-NHPM ID of the patient should mention in the report.

Payment terms & Penalty

- Rates fixed for the tests/ services shall be capped & not exceed the rates published by CGHS from time to time on the following portal, <https://cghs.gov.in/showfile.php?lid=4345>.
- Diagnostic centers/ Laboratories shall raise monthly invoice to the respective District Hospital & the Civil Surgeon shall clear as soon as possible the bills within 30 days of receipt of the bills as per guidelines aforementioned. The payments will be made from the account of Rogi Kalyan Samiti in which fund received from SHA.
- In case of increase in time required for testing on valid ground one day grace may be provided after which penalty amounting to be 5% per day and maximum up to 20% of the cost of the test will be deducted from the bill payment.
- Service provider shall make alternative arrangements for testing all of the samples at the same rates in case there is breakdown which extends for more than 72 hours (3 days) of the sample collection. If the breakdown in the services extends 15 days the contract may be cancelled.

Monitoring

- Civil Surgeon shall nominate team to perform inspection/audit of the diagnostic/laboratories on a quarterly basis for compliance.
- Any non-compliance /grievances may be considered for de-empanelment of vendors.

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AYUSHMAN BHARAT SCHEME

OUTSOURCING OF SPECIALIST DOCTORS GUIDELINES

Guidelines for Hiring of Specialists under Ayushman Bharat Scheme

For the effective implementation of Ayushman Bharat Scheme, & providing end to end free/cashless health care facilities to the beneficiaries it may be necessary to hire specialists on a case to case basis for the services which cannot be offered owing to lack of specialist within the institute. This may help in increasing the ambit of services being offered at the Public hospitals. Following are the general guidelines:

General Guidelines

Following shall be the order of preference for hiring services of specialists

1. Specialists or retired specialists from local Government institution (local medical collages/public health and welfare institution).
2. Specialists from local private sector with over 3 years of clinical experience after post Graduation.
3. Specialists from other district Government institution (local medical collages/public health and welfare institution).
4. Specialists from private sectors of other district.

Hiring related

1. Hiring for the District hospitals, CH & CHC's may be done by advertising in local newspaper or even through referrals, the appointment shall be conducted by Civil Surgeon of the respective districts. An undertaking shall be provided by the respective CS/CMHO regarding the non-availability of the specialist within the institute.
2. MOU shall be signed between the civil surgeon and Specialist hired.
3. Hiring shall be purely on an understanding of remuneration to be paid on a case basis and condition that the Specialist shall be available for any requirement by the institute on a priority basis.
4. Services of Gynecologists, General Surgeons, Anesthetists already sought as per the CeMonc circular may be utilized for Ayushman Bharat Scheme.

Remuneration

Following Remuneration will be used

1. General Surgeon, ENT Surgeon, Ophthalmologist, Gynecologist to be paid INR 3000/- per surgical case.
2. Anesthetist to be paid INR 2000/- per case.
3. Follow up fees for surgical cases will be fixed at INR 1000/- per case. Follow shall be undertaken by the Medical officer posted and only in cases of emergency or requirement based on clinical discretion of Medical Officer shall the specialist be called for the follow up visit.
4. Travelling allowance will be paid to the specialists as per the following criteria.

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Distance	Allowance
0-50 Km	500
51-75 Km	750
76-100 Km	1000
>100 Km	1250

Budget Provision

The claims received under the Ayushman Bharat scheme (Rogi kalyan Samiti) shall be used for provision of specialist fee, travelling allowances etc.
